

Veterans Affairs FAQs

➡ Who do I contact about my VA benefits? GHC Veterans Affairs Coordinator,

➡ What do I need to do to set up my VA benefits for next semester?
Fill out the Veterans Enrollment Form, each semester

➡ How do I apply for Tuition Assistance, MyCAA, or Voc Rehab Book Vouchers?
Contact the 3rd party billing coordinator, in the GHC Business Office

➡ What if I'm being charged out-of-state tuition, but I'm Military?
Active duty/Reservist: GA National Guard & US Reservists, Tuition Differential Waiver
Veterans separated in the last 10 years: Recently Separated Military Waiver

➡ How do I turn in my shot records, if I had all my shots in the military?
Attach a DD214 to your Immunization form, if separated in the last 5 years

➡ Does GHC accept Transfer Credit from the Military?

The Department of Physical Education at Georgia Highlands College provides the following exemptions: PHED 1020, First Aid and CPR for service as a Medic and PHED 1100, Personal Fitness, for basic military training

➡ Does GHC Waive the application fee for Military and their family members?

No. Currently, GHC only waives Mandatory Fees - the waiver does not include Application or Testing Fees

➡ Does GHC participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program? Yes, GHC is a YR School.

➡ What other scholarships are Military students eligible for, besides GI Bill?
Students should always apply for FAFSA and all Institutional Scholarships available

➡ What happens to my VA benefits if I Drop a class? Contact VA Coordinator, Amy Wise

➡ Will my classes be dropped if I have VA Benefits? Check SCORE, also fill out a Veterans Enrollment form each semester you attend GHC.
