 Fill out the Veterans Enrollment Form, each semester
- How do I apply for Tuition Assistance, MyCAA, or Voc Rehab Book Vouchers?

- What if I'm being charged out-of-state tuition, but I'm Military?

 Submit the Out-of-State Tuition Waiver Application for Military and MilitaryConnected Students and supporting documents to residency@highlands.edu
- How do I turn in my shot records, if I had all my shots in the military?

 Attach a DD214 to your Immunization form, if separated in the last 5 years
- <u>Does GHC accept Transfer Credit from the Military?</u> The Department of Physical Education at Georgia Highlands College provides the following exemptions: PHED 1020, First Aid and CPR for service as a Medic and PHED 1100, Personal Fitness, for basic military training
- Does GHC Waive the application fee for Military and their family members?

 Beginning Fall 2021, new Veteran/Active Military applicants will qualify for an application fee waiver.
- <u>Does GHC participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program?</u> Yes, GHC is a YR School.
- What other scholarships are Military students eligible for, besides GI Bill?

 Students should always apply for FAFSA and all Institutional Scholarships available
