**Notes:** On the listed date, time and location(Georgia Highlands College Douglasville Campus),the listed GHC Student (Luke P. Farmer, ID:900152458)visited the campus admission office and told the Campus Enrollment Management Specialist (Nivenitie McDaniel)that he liked guns and then asked her to read a short story he had written about guns on his cell phone. Ms. McDaniel said that after reading his story she immediately became nervous and concerned. She stated that he wrote about a 44 Magnum Handgun and how he was obsessed with everything about this weapon and when asked why did he write about this his response was to post it online to help others and also said that his favorite likes & hobbies were firearms prior to leaving her office.

Ms. McDaniel said that she then reached out to the Campus Director (Julia Areh)and informed her of the words and writings on this student phone that was obviously related to a strong interest in guns. The campus director stated that she was concerned and so she contacted the on-duty Dynamic Campus Safety Officer (Lena Lay)and briefed her on the matter and requested that she monitor the student while she notify Sergeant Grant by phone of this incident. The campus director advised this officer of the above aforementioned information and stated that under the circumstances she had already initiated 2 Care Tickets on this student and procedurally submitted them to the Office of Student Services. I advised her that a police report will be generated as a result of this incident and for documentation purposes and that I will follow-up with the on-duty campus safety officer (Lena Lay) for further.

Shortly thereafter, Lena Lay (On-Duty Dynamic Campus Security Officer)contacted this officer and stated that the same student inadvertently approached her and showed her his short story and asked her to read it. She stated that she became concerned and decided to give me (Sergeant Grant) a phone call in regards to this matter. The officer was encouraged to continue strategically monitoring the student and advised that considering all, the student appeared to be his normal and usual self. She stated that he subsequently left campus for the day and without further incident. This is a non-criminal incident at the time and will continue to be monitored. At the moment the matter is actively being handled by the Office of Student Services and Counseling.

Notes: It was reported that on Wednesday 02-21-2018 between 0835-0845 Hours, an unknown black male (Short Curly Hair, Thin Mustache, Between 5'9" and 6'1", Wearing Blue Jean Pants and a Dalton State Road Runners Charcoal Colored Hoodie)approached the Regional GPSTC Academy Session Class Number 7 and blurted out several profanities. The entire Session Class Number 7 stated that this incident occurred while they were conducting Flag Detail in front of the McCorkle Building and that the unknown black male was possibly a GHC student and was 10 or more feet away from when he uttered profanities directed to them. According to their written statement forms the profanities used sounded like "Fuck the Police and Fuck the Flag, and or Serve my Nuts, These Nuts or Suck these Nuts. The unknown black male then just stared at them with a facial frown and then turned away and walked into the McCorkle Building without further incident. The entire group (Session Class Number 7)then advised that they notified their training supervisors (Lt. Forrest Jones and Lt. Barnes/Training Coordinators) of this incident and Lt. Jones in turn reached out to Chief David Horace (GHC Police Department)and alerted him of this matter.

Notes: On 02/28/2018 at approximately 1025 Hours, I (Sergeant R Grant/On Paulding Campus)received a phone call from the on-duty Douglasville Campus Safety Security Officer (Dynamic Security Guard: Adriyana Carmichael)In reference to an "Irate Person" that was refusing to leave. Officer Carmichael stated that the unknown person had arrived on campus several minutes earlier to inquire about enrollment. Officer Carmichael said moments after his arrival she was contacted by the campus student assistant and asked to report to the Dean Office in regards to an unknown male yelling profanities at the Campus Dean. Upon arriving at the Dean Office she observed the unknown male who was thought to be a potential student yelling out profanities and saying disrespectful things to the Dean (Julla Areh) such as "Black women are stupid, they make us look bad and that the Dean was acting like a Bitch, and that all of the Black women on the campus was disrespectful to him." At this time, she called this officer and advised me of the situation and I told her to call 911 since Douglasville Police could be there in minutes but the unknown male decided to allow her to escort him off the property as requested by the Campus Dean and did so without incident. The unknown male's name was Hendrix Adu and his identification number was 900156155 and no-further personal information available on this person. He was described as: Black Male of African Descent, Slender Built, Dark Skinned, Low-Cut Hair Style with well trimmed Facial Hair, He was wearing a Blue Colored Hawaiian Shirt with Palm Trees on it and a pair of Dark Colored Khaki Pants/Trousers, no-further).
