Notes: The Complainant (Victim/Alexandria B. Minick, KSU Student ID Number:000549364) stated that on 06/18/2018 at approximately 1246 Hours, she arrived on campus and parked her automobile (Listed Vehicle) on the Georgia Highlands College & KSU Paulding Instructional Site in the Main Student Lot (West Griffin Street/S Johnston Street). She then exited her automobile afoot (Listed Vehicle) and then headed to class and did not notice anything unusual or any damage to her vehicle.

The complainant said that later on this date, she returned to her vehicle at approximately 1710 Hours, and observed an elongated crack across her entire Rear-Back Window and did not see any suspicious objects or person (s) in the area that may have been responsible. She immediately reported this incident to the GHC On-Duty Dynamic Security Officer (Isaiah Thompson) who then notified this officer (Sergeant R Grant/GHC PD).

The complainant advised me that she was unsure of what or who, caused the damage (Cracked Window) to her vehicle's window and at the moment she was not ruling out the heat from the sun. I advised her that I will review and replay the campus parking camera's in an effort to assist in determining the causation of her cracked rear window. Prior to completing the review I was notified by the complainant that she decided to go ahead and file a Damage to Property Report (Case Number 2018-06535) with the City of Dallas Police Department at the urging of her parents.

Shortly thereafter, I subsequently reached out to the complainant and advised her that I completed the camera review check for the date and times in question and did not observe anyone or anything that could have caused the damage to her vehicle. The complainant was then issued Georgia Highlands College Police Department Case Number IR06192018-0011 as documentation of this incident.
