On Tuesday, 09/25/2018 at 0945 Hours, I (Sergeant R Grani/GHC PD) received a phone call from Detective Weaver (Unit #402) of the City of Dallas Police Department requesting to meet with this officer in reference to an individual possibly involved in a "Hit & Run Incident". The incident in question occurred on 09/21/2018 between 1030-1240 Hours, and happened somewhere near E Memorial Drive and possibly N Johnston Street and within the Dallas, Georgia City Limits.

Detective Weaver then said that he was hopeful that the Georgia Highlands College (Paulding Campus) exterior surveillance camera located on the Southwest side of the George T. Bagby Building which faces the intersection of South Johnston Street/West Griffin Street may have picked-up Driver-One (1) in the area on the date and times provided. He stated that this was important because this driver initially stated that he did not drive his motorcycle to work on the listed date and times. He said he therefore needed this officer assistance for this investigative process to help him determine if the driver was in the referenced incident area on the date & times provided and more importantly if he was on a motorcycle (Black Colored Harley Davison).

I advised Detective Weaver that I will next be on the Paulding Campus on Wednesday, 09/26/2018 and would be available to meet with him at his convenience. We met on the Paulding Campus at 1315 Hours, and after monitoring the Paulding-Remote Parking Camera, at around 1445 Hours, Detective Weaver and I observed the individual in question (Driver of Vehicle-1) was indeed in the area and was also seen operating a black colored motorcycle. Detective Weaver advised that this was very helpful and key to his investigation. He advised this officer that due to the surveillance proof, I will be asked and subpoenaed to testify because the supportive evidence was owned by GHC PD and was in our possession and jurisdiction. I advised him that I am prepared to assist in the criminal process as however needed.
