CAMPUS	DESCRIPTION	DELIVERY
Cartersville, Floyd, Heritage Hall, Paulding, Marietta	Classes meet in person on the days and times listed in Course Offerings .	Synchronous
Hybrid	Classes meet in person on the day, time, and location listed in Course Offerings, and there is also a required online component, typically delivered via D2L.	Synchronous
GHC Online	Classes do not meet at a designated location or time. Students log-in to D2L to complete coursework. Students should be motivated and great at time-management. Assignments and assessments must be completed by due dates outlined in the course syllabus.	Asynchronous
eClassroom	Classes meet live online on the day and time listed in Course Offerings. Students must use GHC's Zoom web meeting system, which is a free application that can be accessed via a computer, tablet, or phone. A high-speed internet connection is required.	Synchronous
eCore/eMajor	Online classes that are offered through a partnership with the University System of Georgia and are taught by faculty from various institutions in the USG. Students log in to GoView to complete coursework.	Asynchronous

SYNCHRONOUS

WHAT?

- Students and instructors meet together at the same time for all class sessions.
- Some classes meet on campus. These classes will state the campus name (Cartersville, Douglasville, etc.)
- Some classes meet via [Zoom](#). These are called eClassroom classes.
- Synchronous classes meet on the days and times listed in Course Offerings.

OFFERS

- Live interaction with instructors and other students
- Immediate answers to questions

REQUIRES

- Reliable high-speed internet
- A commitment to be in class for every session
- Willingness to interact live with other students and the instructor

ASYNCHRONOUS

WHAT?

- Students and instructors do not meet for any class sessions.
- Instructors deliver all course materials via D2L. Students log in and complete the work independently.
- Some instructors offer optional [Zoom](#) sessions and may record the sessions for students who cannot attend.
- Classes are labeled as GHC Online in Course Offerings.

OFFERS

- Flexibility to work on material when it fits your schedule within the timeframe set by the instructor
- Flexibility to work from any location with reliable internet
- Connection to classmates and instructor via email or chat apps

REQUIRES

- Reliable high-speed internet
- Time management skills to complete tasks independently
- Willingness to interact with other students and the instructor via email, chat, discussion boards, etc.
