- The student is responsible for payment of any outstanding tuition and fees to the HOST Institution by their applicable fee payment deadlines. Reimbursement of any Federal financial aid (if applicable) will be refunded to the student later in the semester by GHC.
- You may be required to return Federal financial aid to GHC if you drop/withdraw from classes at the HOST or HOME institution causing your original eligibility to change.
- A final, official transcript from the HOST institution must be sent to Georgia Highlands College once your grades are finalized at the HOST institution.
