#2: SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION

FRONT-PAGE FEBRUARY: DAILY NEWS YOU CAN USE

Pose a question in video or text. Ask students

video or text. Ask students to respond in a small group discussion forum in D2L. Share group reports to the full-class discussion forum. Ask students to use digital pin boards, like Padlet, to share content & have a discussion.

ONLINE-SYNCHRONOUS

Use Zoom breakout rooms. Have students record thoughts on shared collaborative document like Google Docs. Between live sessions, have small teams meet to work on group brainstorming, creating, or problem solving assignments.

Form groups of 3-5 students. Pose a question.

Perhaps use a collaborative (e.g., Google) doc to ease communication or send groups out of classroom for socially-distanced discussion elsewhere with a set return time. Give students roles (e.g., recorder or reporter). Remind students to project voices when giving report, so all can hear.
