Psychology 1101 Honors Plan of Action, Spring, 2018

The purpose of this defined plan of study is to initiate and complete three field experiences that would allow Margaret to apply psychological principles to individuals at different age periods. The description of the plan of action will be based on guidelines established by the Georgia Highlands Honors Program.

The three topics for the assigned field experiences will be:

- An interview of two children ages five to seven, one male and one female. The purpose of this interview will be to ask a defined set of questions to each child, and then compare the answers to determine the differences in responses based on gender.

The summary must include a title page typed APA style, the question responses, and a summation of the results utilizing psychological principles as a basis for the comparison. There must also be a written consent form signed by the parent or guardian for both children to be included in the field experience

- An interview of a married couple who have been married at least twenty-five years. The interviews will be conducted separately with both partners being asked the same questions, then brought together to answer the same questions again to see if their answers differ when they are together, also to observe the rapport between them.

The summary must include a title page typed APA style, the question responses, and a summation of the results utilizing psychological principles as a basis for the comparison. There should also be a signed consent form agreeing to participate.

- A general observation to be completed at Walmart, or a similar location, the purpose being to find evidence of the differences observed in the behavior of a variety of people, and to offer psychological analyses of possible causes of the behavior.

The summary must include a title page typed APA style, the gender and approximate ages of those observed, and a summation of the results utilizing psychological principles as a basis for the analyses. No consent is necessary since there is no personal identification of those being observed.
