* Students must retake required Biology courses if taken more than 6 years before application.
** Practicing LPNs can request a waiver to extend the age of their Biology courses to 10 years - directions are available on the <a href="#">Nursing FAQ</a>
*** Students must make at least a C or better in BIOL 2121K, BIOL 2122K, BIOL 2161K, ENGL 1101, and MATH 1001 (or MATH 1111)
