<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimum of 2.5 GPA in required general academic courses.</li> <li>• Applicants for the bridge program must be finishing their final prerequisites in the <b>summer semester</b> of application. This is to ensure applicants will have all prerequisites completed for a competitive admission score.</li> <li>• LPN/Paramedics require a Georgia state license.</li> <li>• TEAS required within two years of application (August 2nd - August 1st); applicants can have no more than <b>four</b> attempts at the TEAS in any application cycle - <b>minimum composite: 70</b></li> <li>• LPN/Paramedics are eligible to apply for the Traditional ASN program - the LPN/Paramedic licenses will now be accepted, if applying for the Traditional ASN program</li> <li>• Application deadline: August 15th (yearly)</li> <li>• Nursing information sessions are mandatory - visit the <a href="#">Nursing website</a> for event information.</li> </ul>

* Students must make at least a C or better in BIOL 2251/L, BIOL 2252/L, BIOL 2260/L, ENGL 1101, and MATH 1001 <i>(will accept higher level Math or STAT 1401)</i> .
** Upon successful completion of NURS 1300 & NURS 1400, students receive prior learning credit for NURS 1000, 1001, 1002, 1100, and 1200
*** Students who transfer in HIST 2110 (Survey of US History) will receive points in their admission score. These students <b>MUST</b> complete a course substitution form in order to satisfy their US & GA History requirements for graduation - these are not guaranteed and if denied, students must take either HIST 2111 or 2112.
