GEORGIA HIGHLANDS COLLEGE AND BERRY COLLEGE

Georgia Highlands College Degree Program:
Bachelor of Business Administration in Healthcare Management

Berry College Degree Program:
Master of Business Administration: Track - Healthcare Management

Amendments may be made as necessary and must be agreed upon by both Georgia Highlands College and Berry College.

Graduates of Georgia Highlands College with the Bachelor of Business Administration in Healthcare Management Degree may apply for admission to Berry College's Master of Business Administration in Healthcare Management Program.

- Students must complete in good standing the requirements for graduation at Georgia Highlands College for the Bachelor of Business Administration in Healthcare Management.
- Students must submit all materials required for entrance into the MBA-Healthcare Management program.
- Students applying to the Berry MBA program who graduate from Georgia Highlands College with a 3.0 GPA or higher in the last 60 hours of their degree qualify for a GMAT/GRE waiver. Students not meeting this requirement may still apply to the program but will be required to submit GMAT/GRE test scores to complete their application.

Georgia Highlands College and the Berry College MBA program agree to responsibilities as described:

- Georgia Highlands College will inform students of this articulation agreement and inform the Coordinator of the Bachelor of Business Administration program, who advises all the BBA students, of this articulation agreement.
- Georgia Highlands College students will consult with an Admissions Counselor, and an appropriate plan of needed courses leading to the Master of Business Administration in Healthcare Administration degree will be developed.
- The Berry College MBA program will provide Georgia Highlands College with marketing materials for distribution to students and be available to speak to student groups and/or classes, as requested.

This agreement will continue in effect until it is modified by mutual consent or cancelled by either party. Any student agreements signed before modification or cancellation will be honored.
