An Articulation Agreement Between the University of West Georgia and Georgia Highlands College Associate of Arts in Psychology and Bachelor of Science in Psychology

Explanation of Agreement:

This is a Joint Institutional Agreement on the part of the University of West Georgia (UWG) and Georgia Highlands College (GHC) to formally establish an educational partnership between the two institutions. This agreement is made between GHC's School of Social Sciences and Education Associate of Arts (AA) - Psychology degree and the UWG's College of Arts, Culture, and Scientific Inquiry regarding the Bachelor of Science (BS) in Psychology offered in the Department of Anthropology, Psychology, and Sociology. In this agreement, UWG and GHC are collectively referred to as the parties.

The objectives of the agreement are to provide a partnership between UWG and GHC that will allow students to enroll at GHC, complete an AA - Psychology degree, and be eligible to enroll with a major status into the BS in Psychology in the College of Arts, Culture and Scientific Inquiry at UWG.

The parties will:

- work to identify, recruit, and select students who clearly demonstrate academic and personal competencies required to function as successful students in the program.
- facilitate the transfer of all viable college courses as required in the University System of Georgia core curriculum.
- facilitate the transfer of AA level credits (GHC) towards completion of a BS program (UWG).
- create a seamless pipeline for AA degree (GHC) to BS degree (UWG).

Acceptance of Transfer Credit at the University of West Georgia:

The following guidelines are used to award transfer credit:

- The transfer of credits is consistent with and subject to the conditions prescribed in each institution's published catalog at the time of the student's transfer request.
- Completion of the AA Psychology degree at GHC does not guarantee admission to the BS in Psychology programs at UWG.
- Candidates must successfully meet all requirements to gain admission to the University of West Georgia.

This agreement will be reviewed annually by both parties to ensure continued transfer compatibility of courses. This agreement is in effect for a period of five years, at which time it may be reviewed and renewed. The agreement can be dissolved at any time by the written request of either of the parties listed above.

Requirements:

- Earn an overall GPA of 2.0 at GHC
- Complete requirements for the AA- Psychology degree

Course Equivalencies Relevant to Core and Major Requirements:

The table on the following page displays course equivalencies between GHC and UWG in the Core and in the Psychology Major where applicable.

Transfer students must complete all coursework necessary in their respective degree plan of study before receiving their AA from Georgia Highlands College or their BS from the University of West Georgia. This agreement is subject to change in order to comply with college requirements.
