Fill - in - the – Blank Constitution

A major problem faced by students starting a new group is coming up with a workable constitution. Looking at other constitutions helps, but they can be more complicated than an organization needs.

The following fill – in - the – blank constitution is offered as a possibility. You can add to, or delete, almost any portion. There are a few sections that are required to be in all constitutions, or bylaws, for recognized organizations. These are: purpose, non-discrimination clause, membership selection method, membership termination method, officer duties, officer term of office, financial obligations, and type/frequency of meetings.

These have been written into the following sample constitution under the following:

Article III, Section 1, 2, 3, and 4 dealing with membership

Article IV, Section 3 and 4 dealing with officer's duties and term of office

Article V outlining officer eligibility: and

Article VI detailing meetings

Article VII stating financial obligations

Article VIII, Sections 2 and 3 limiting the powers of the organization to those authorized by Georgia Highlands College
