

Student Accommodations Information for Faculty



Students with documented disabilities are entitled to reasonable accommodations designed to provide equal access.

DISABILITY ACCESS RESPONSIBILITIES



- Determine appropriate accommodations on a case-by-case basis
- Creates the Faculty Accommodation Notice (FAN)
- Provides the FAN as a PDF document to the student and course faculty to communicate approved accommodations

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES



- Complete the initial accommodations request process
- Request a new FAN each semester by providing Disability Access with their course schedule
- Communicate with course faculty about their accommodations each semester

FACULTY RESPONSIBILITIES



- Review FAN when received
- Contact Disability Access if you have questions or concerns about the listed accommodations
- Communicate with the student as to how the approved accommodations will be provided in your course
- Implement approved accommodations on FAN
- Keep a copy of the FAN to refer to throughout the semester
- Refer students who self-disclose a disability to our office

Note: Faculty are not required to provide accommodations that fundamentally alter the core requirements of the course.



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
